Edufront Goes 100% Online under Phase 2 (Heightened Alert)

Following the nationwide restrictions under Phase 2 (Heightened Alert) and the advisory from the Ministry of Education, please be informed that physical lessons at all our centres will be moved online from 17 May to 13 June 2021. Compared to the start of the pandemic last year, we are now much better prepared to cope with the changes and ensure that our students can continue to meet the learning objectives and excel in the online classes.

1. No Changes to Class Schedule

To minimise disruptions to the scheduling and students' learning, our tutors will be conducting the online lessons following the same class schedule. Parents will receive the links before the start of the class via WhatsApp. Our tutors will be using popular video-conferencing apps such as Zoom, Google Meet or Clickmeeting. Kindly ensure that your child has good headphones and microphones to maximise engagement and tutor-student interaction. Parents are also welcomed to join in the sessions with your children.

2. Homework Submission – Personalised Folder

Submission and return of students' work will be made entirely online via g-drive. We have created a personalised folder for each student to upload their completed work for marking. Kindly contact our centre coordinators if you have yet to receive the links to your child's folder.

3. Home Delivery of Materials (Hardcopies)

We are making arrangements for the home delivery of June tuition materials via SingPost (PolyM). You should receive the package in your letter box by 31 May 2021. This will save parents and students valuable time and the hassle of downloading and printing the huge amount of materials. Kindly contact our admin staff at the respective centres if you do not receive them by 31 May.

4. Learning Management System (Ims.wizlearn.com/edufront)

All Edufront students have their own unique LMS account and will have exclusive access to a wide range of learning resources in the programmes they are registered in. Some of the features of the LMS:

- Convenient access to Learning Materials, softcopies of worksheets and weekly recorded online lessons
- Test papers and quizzes with automated marking for drill and practice and revision of concepts
- Forum discussions with our tutors/Homework Hero for daily homework help
- Track student learning progress with report
